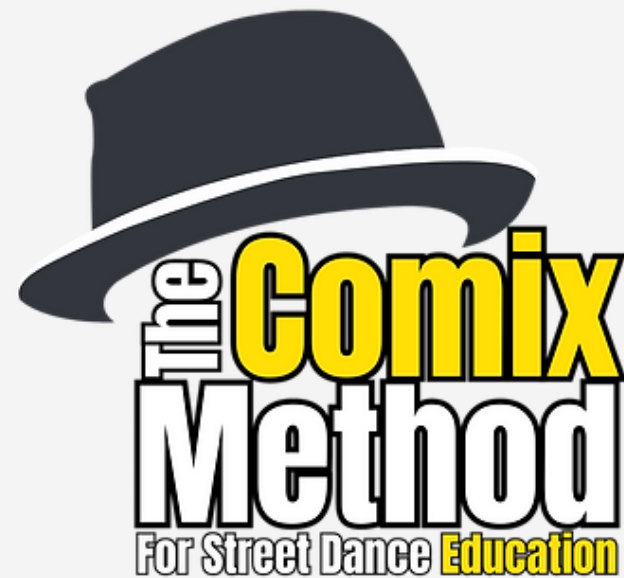

Lisa is trained by Yoga Kids Training Academy, accredited by Yoga Alliance International and Yoga Australia - 50hr qualification.

Our teachers follow the Discover Dance curriculum and resources for our Tot Bots and Pre-Primary classes.

About Us...

Jess began Tech Steps in 2013 after studying Ballet, Tap and Character (BAL syllabus) from Mrs. Myra Di Maria in Penguin and Jazz and Hip Hop from several other studios (Stardust, Relflexions, Kim Roe,) and completing University degrees in Theatre and Teaching.

Over the years, Tech Steps has grown considerably with Jess finding diamonds amongst the dance community to add to the much loved staff team. Both Lisa and Eve trained with Pam's Dance Studio and have rich histories of stage performances. Nicky trained with Myra Di Maria in Penguin, and Taryn has been with the studio since she was 9yrs old and now holds a teaching Certificate and Advanced BAL genre certificates. Our young assistant teachers all hold exam certificates with Honours and are dedicated to their craft and continuously learning as we all are.

We are very proud of how our small studio has grown and the community that holds our values and beliefs to heart. Our students continuously amaze us with their work ethic and drive to achieve personal goals such as exams and outstanding performances on stage.

In 2023 Tech Steps Dance Studio was awarded 2nd in the country for Junior Jazz and Hip Hop BAL grades. The same year, Jess was recognised as a 'Diamond of Devonport' for outstanding achievement in dance education.

In 2024 we were awarded 1st place for Junior Jazz and Hip Hop grades and 2nd for Tap'n'Beats.

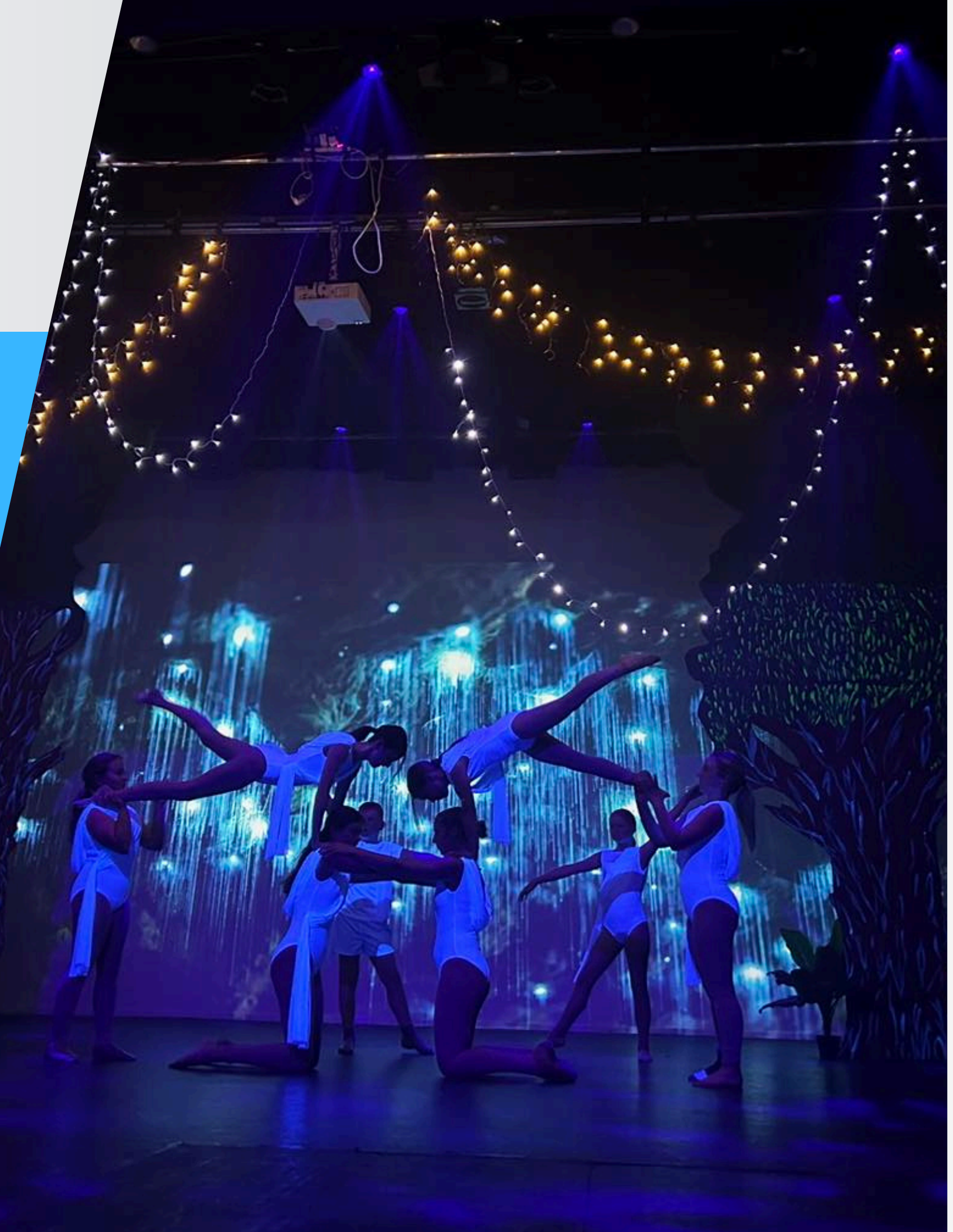

WHAT ARE

EXAMS ?

JAZZ, TAP, HIP-HOP & ACRO

The BAL and Acro exams comprise of a series of steps that a student must execute to the best of their ability.

They are marked by a BAL registered or an Acrobatic Dance Association examiner.

The BAL exams are moderated throughout Australia, New Zealand and Indonesia.

Entries are in July each year, with exams in August or September.

Students selected for an exam, can access private lessons leading up to the exam date.

On completion of a grade, a student will advance to the next level, in the following year.

PRODUCTIONS ?

END OF YEAR STUDIO PERFORMANCE

Our end of year shows, are adaptations of well known fairy tales. Previous productions include The Lion King, Peter Pan and Alice, to name a few.

Students are invited to audition for lead roles and our whole studio is involved; all performing in the show.

We believe in teaching our students about professional theatre etiquette, promoting commitment, dedication and team work.

We perform in a working theatre, where students learn about technical theatre elements and terminology.

The skills learned while working on a show are transferable to a wide variety of career paths and aspects of life.

MAKE UP & HAIR

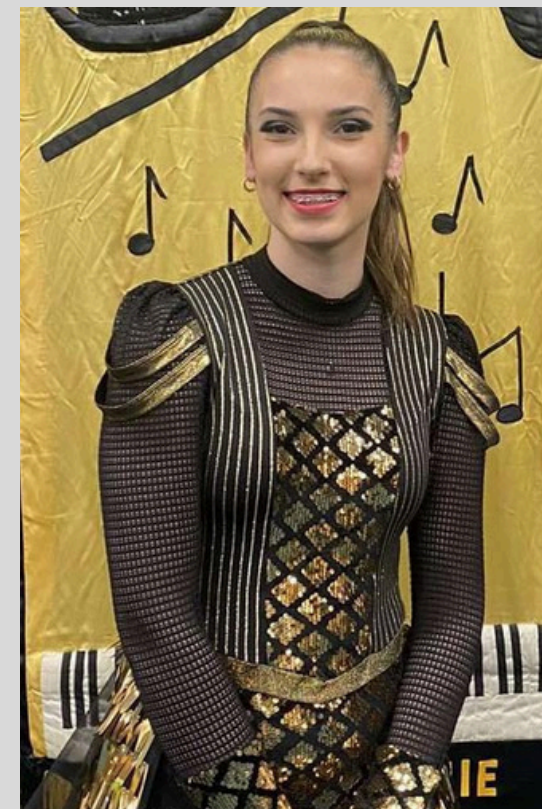
Make up and Hair styles are a part of the dance and theatre industry, our aim is to slowly introduce students to these aspects in an appropriate way as they grow.

Tot Bots classes, (ages 3-5) not required to wear make-up.

Pre-Primary Jazz classes, (ages 5-7) basic make-up introduced.

Primary classes and above, wear make up, ONLY for on stage performances under theatre lights.

Stage make up is important as theatre lighting distorts the view of the face and make up can counteract this affect. We send out instructions on how to apply stage make up before our end of year production, and also a video tutorial or instructions of how to create the hair style that fits the student's character in the show.

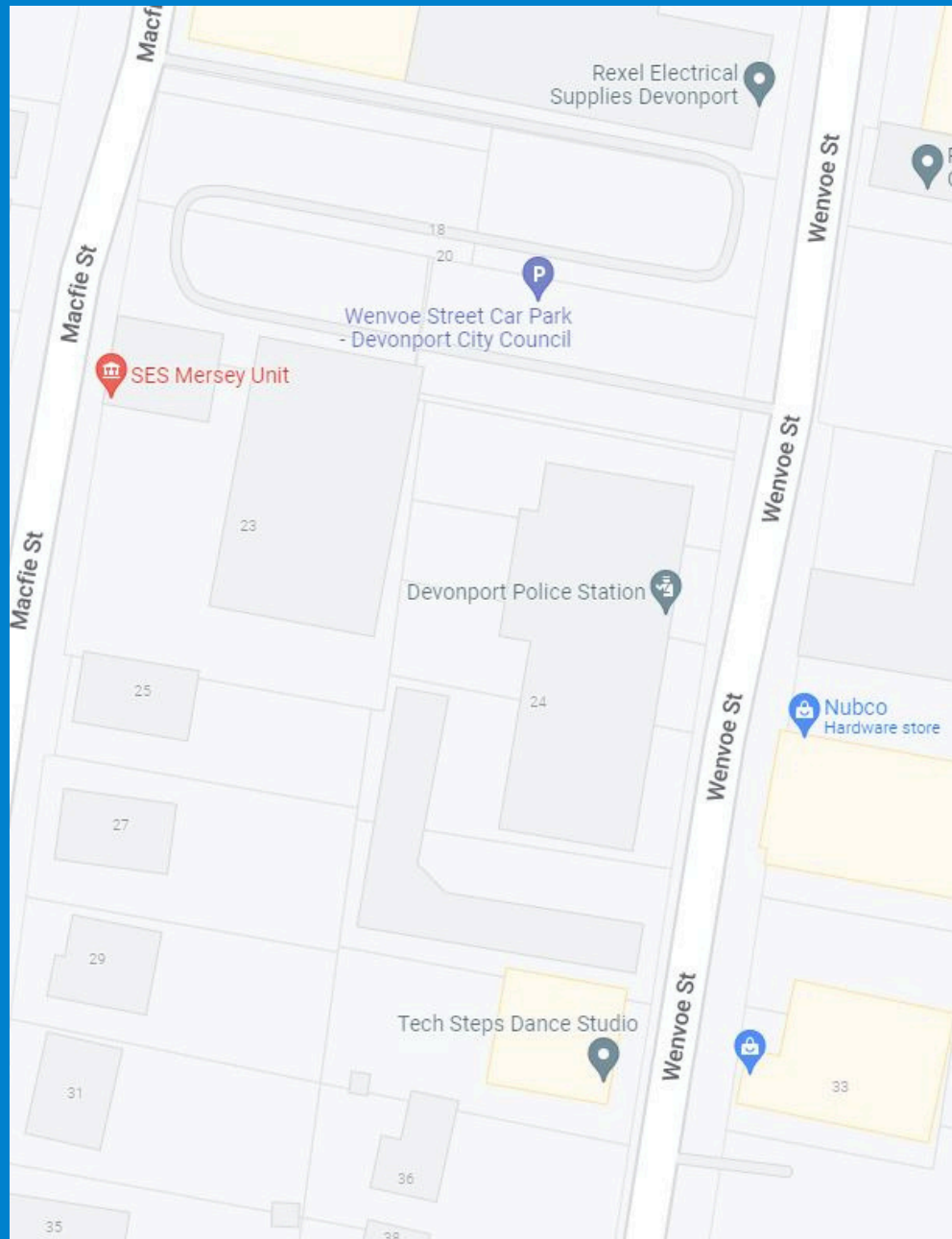

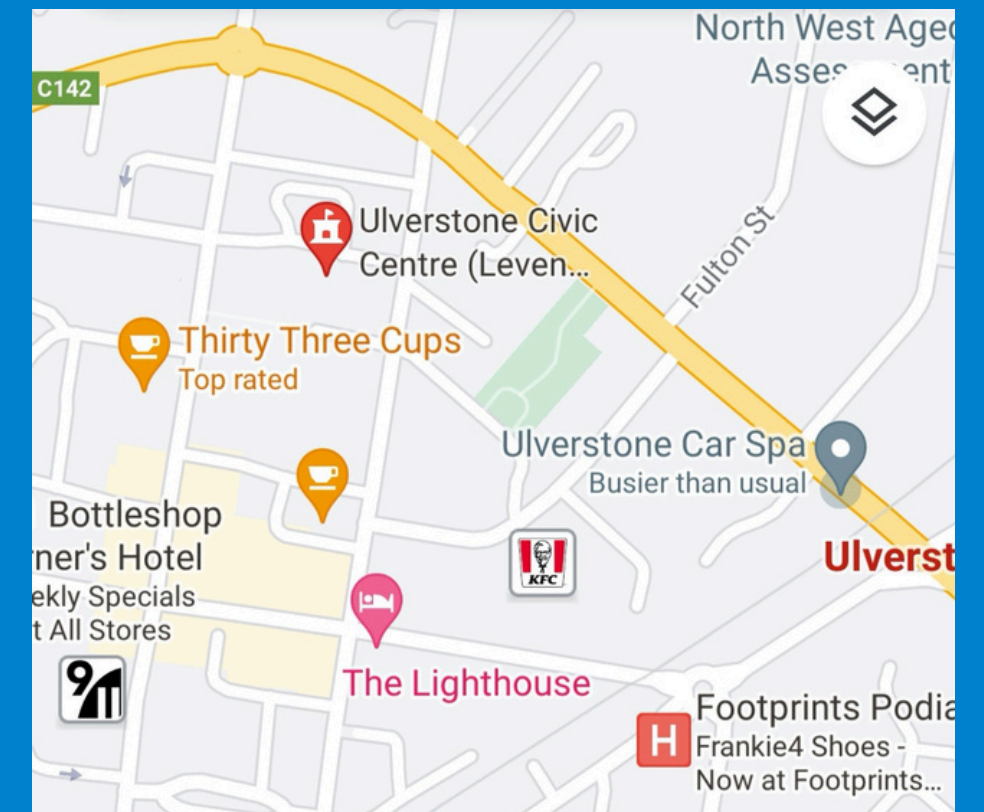

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What do I do if my child is sick or absent?

You can lodge an absence via your app. Go to > PARENT PORTAL > MORE > ATTENDANCE > CLICK on child > SELECT the date they will be absent from class.

How can I support them at home when working towards a dance or exam steps?

Music tracks for performances can be added to files in your app, at your request. Teachers provide a list of exam steps, with music in Term 3, for students to practice, and videos of steps can be uploaded for students who have missed multiple lessons. Report cards are also submitted by teachers to review and assist with improvement at home.

Can I pay my outstanding bill in parts?

Yes, sure thing! You can pay in instalments via the app by going to > PORTAL > PAY > select 'OTHER' > select 'BALANCE' > ENTER the amount you wish to pay, towards your balance. Direct deposit is also available, details are included at the bottom of our monthly statements.

My child has outgrown their dance gear, what can I do?

You can list dance items on our Facebook Buy and Sell group. Just take a photo, upload and provide details on condition and price.

Is make-up involved in preparing for a show?

Yes! For our end of year production, photo day and public events such as, eisteddfods or community functions. We send out instructions, including photos, on how to apply proper stage make-up on your child.
